: **OFFICE ORDER** :

Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority in its 124th Authority meeting held on 10th Feb ,2009 accorded its approval for setting up an Innovation Park in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR) and has also made a Budget provision of Rs. 1.00 crore for initial studies etc.

Innovation Park as a growth centre will be the first of its kind project in entire country and will act as a catalyst in synergizing science and technology with the need of the industry and will act as focal point where industry and research activities will give direction to the development of science and activities for overall holistic growth of the region and society as a whole. Development of Innovation Park as growth centre will create avenues for employment in MMR and will boost the economic growth in the region. About 25,000 Scientists from over 100 countries will be conducting their R & D at the Innovation Park.

To enable crystallise the concept of Innovation Park, to compare the global success stories, to study the impact on the region in terms of economic stimulus, employment, spill over effects, value addition to the nation etc. and to identify a suitable site appoint a consultant and to undertake all the tasks necessary to execute the project the following VISION GROUP is hereby constituted:-

The above Vision Group shall prepare the concept plan for Innovation park , shall identify the alternative areas for setting up the park , shall undertake techno economic feasibility study , undertake preparation of DPR, shall recommend upon the probable models of joint ventures, etc . The Group shall hold dialogue with various stakeholders and conduct meetings and site visits as necessary.

The above Vision Group shall meet regularly and submit their recommendations through Addl. Metropolitan Commissioner to the Metropolitan Commissioner, MMRDA every month.

The Group members shall be entitled for T.A./D.A and to and fro air travel to attend the meeting. An honorarium of Rs.3000/- per meeting shall be paid to the non-official members at sr. no.2,3,5,6,7 above. The Group shall have liberty to add any other member from industry, etc to facilitate the implementation of this project. The Vision Group shall submit its Inception Report before 15th August 2009.
